October 24 Halloween Party/Hay Ride





TIMBERLAKE COUNCIL MEETING February 18, 2014

Mayor Cattani opened the meeting with the pledge to the flag at 7:30 PM. After the public portion, Mayor Cattani asked for the roll call of the officers.

The mayor asked for a motion to approve December 17, 2013 minutes

The mayor asked for a motion to approve January 28, 2014 minutes.

SAFETY

Dennis Dicki explained that the speed limit on East Shore cannot be changed due to state law. Radar will continue to be continued in this area. The cross roads of East Shore, Owaissa, and Nepahwin will be made into a six way stop sign area for safety concerns and it should also help with the control of the speed limit. This will be completed with signs as soon as the weather breaks. The new police cruiser is at the dealership in Solon waiting for equipment to be installed. We received a grant from Homeland Security to install a laptop computer into the cruiser that will be connected to the Lake County system.

SERVICE

Mike Stanton reported that Timberlake has been lucky to receive our shipments of salt as ordered. We have gone through 75 tons of salt already this season.

TOWN HALL

Ritu Sharma reported that rentals for February were slow but March already has 12 bookings. Still receiving quotes for the exit signs.

FINANCE

Dennis Dicki presented Resolution 2014-11 approving and directing payment of certain bills by the Village of Timberlake, and declaring and emergency. This resolution is to pay the monthly bills.

Mike Stanton made a motion to do a second reading of 2013-51 regarding property lines of a five foot setback. We are trying to update this ordinance that originated in 1957. The Planning Commission is to meet March 11, 2014 at 7:00PM. This is an open public meeting.

TREES & PARKS

Mary Trepal did research regarding sidewalks on Lake Shore Blvd. We are looking into a possible grant for this project. The feeling is that sidewalks would add to the safety of walkers and bicyclist.

The mayor has spoken to Pete Formica regarding looking into a grant again for paving and resurfacing.
